GOOD NEWS on hold
until ALL PLEDGES are MADE

1. The Archdiocese has given permission for St. Anna's to have this Pledge Drive upon the condition that a minimum of \$800,000 is pledged (they are our "bank" and will not allow us to raise funds for the Parking Lot without securing our outstanding loans by pledges.
The \$150,000 for Parking Lot plus our loan balance of \$642,000 = \$792,000).
2. We now have **\$235,000** in pledges so we **still need \$615,000 to reach our goal of \$850,000.**
3. The vote taken at St. Anna's town hall meeting last Sunday revealed that, by a margin of 67 to 3, voters preferred to pay off the entire debt with pledge money first before even considering taking out another loan.

The next decision, made by a margin of 67 to 6 votes, was to wait and put pledge money in savings until we can pay for parking lot.

4. The third decision made was which parishioner-suggested improvements would also be funded with pledge money if reach our goal of \$850,000
 - A. Gutters to help prevent discoloration
 - B. Sound systems for hall & outdoor events
 - C. Storage cabinet in parish hall.
 - D. Dishwasher replaced to reduce back strain.
