

# Lenten regulations

Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday (March 1st), Good Friday (April 14th) and all Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years and older. Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 years of age. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. *Those who are sick, pregnant, or nursing, or whose health would be adversely affected by fasting or abstinence one not bound by these norms.*
