This final stage of Jesus Christ's ministry remains closely linked to his first descend from heaven in the Incarnation. "No one has ascended into heaven, but he who descended from heaven, the Son of man." Left to our own natural powers, humanity does not have access to the "Father's house" or to God's life and happiness. Only Christ can open such access and we, his members, have confidence that we too shall go where he, our Head and our Source, has preceded us.

"And I, when I am lifted up from the Earth, will draw all men to myself." The lifting up of Jesus on the cross signifies and begins his lifting up by his Ascension into heaven. Jesus Christ, the one priest of the new and eternal Covenant, "entered, not into a sanctuary made by human hands. . . but into heaven itself, to appear in the presence of God on our behalf." There Christ permanently exercises his priesthood, for he "always lives to make intercession" for "those who draw near to God through him". As "high priest of the good things to come" he is the center and the principal actor of the liturgy that honors the Father in heaven. AMEN.
