

## BODY + BLOOD of CHRIST

Think about this: it is the night before you know will be your last day on earth before your death.

You are with your followers celebrating the greatest religious ritual of your people: Passover.

You know the ritual and the order of the parts that give it a set, familiar pattern (like the Mass).

[ this is a unlikely but possible scenario, you could do this.. If you did, wouldn't the fact that you chose to have your friends celebrate this ritual with you on your last night on earth be clearly saying how important it is to you. Its very important to JESUS]

**Then He changes the words! He says: "this is my Body ...given for you...take and eat. This is my Blood...the Blood of the New and Eternal Covenant"**

[ He must have supreme authority to do this. This is the *only* time Jesus uses the term 'covenant' which is 'a divine promise establishing or modifying God's relationship to humanity.' ]

.....Jesus then drops the Order of Service completely and after giving "the Last Discourse" He leads the Apostles into a garden to pray....BUT to finish the Passover the Fourth/ Last cup of blessed wine must of offered and consumed. ....The next day nailed to a cross when offered sour wine it touches His lips, and with HIS last breath struggles to lift his body so as to take a breath and struggle to say: "It is finished."

[To participate in the Passover Ritual—a set pattern of prayer—you had to partake of 4 symbolic cups of wine AND had to eat the flesh of the Passover lamb!

Its important to realize the for Jesus to say "it is finished" was extremely painful for He had to lift his body, that was secured by nails to cross, so he could take in enough air into his lungs that were filling with Blood.]

1. He told us to "Do this in memory of me" the day before His death—It must be Very Important for us!

2. As the Son of God He uses His Divine authority to modify a divine promise establishing God's new relationship to humanity "sealed in His Blood."

3. As the Son of Man He uses all of His remaining human strength, after tasting of the Fourth Cup, to say "it is finished" then He dies. Jesus finishes the purpose for which He was sent: our Redemption.

V:29 For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly [In 2 senses: your physical body and as Church body. My point: believe and take to heart!!

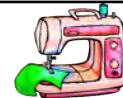
held June 20th to the 24th with dinner from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. and the program from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.

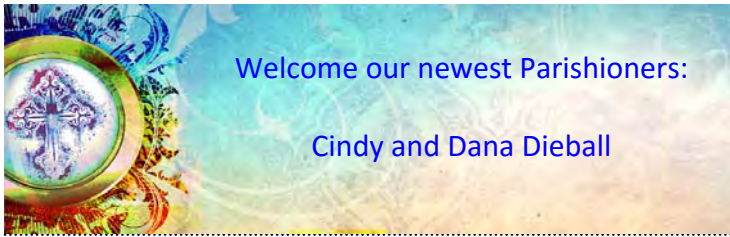


### YOUTH MINISTRY NEWS
