

***“Blessed are those called.....  
.....to the Supper of the Lamb”\****

**Today’s parable points beyond itself to the revealed mystery of the Most Holy Trinity's plan of salvation.**

**6 Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the roar of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, crying out, “Hallelujah! For the Lord our God the Almighty reigns.**

**7 Let us rejoice and exult and give him the glory, (#1) for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready (#2);**

**8 it was granted her (#3) to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure”—for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints (#4).**

**9 And the angel said<sup>[a]</sup> to me, “Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.”(#5) And he said to me, “These are the true words of God.” (#6)**

- Revelation 19:6-9

**(#1) Let us rejoice and exult and give him the glory**—Jesus alone is the Holy One. He is our Savior. The glory is His alone which we share by His Mercy!

**(#2) His Bride has made herself ready;**—United with the Lord in faith, hope and love we are to make ourselves ready. Making ourselves ready we live our faith and are transformed by “grace”. We are not saved by work as just stated above but are given the grace and responsibility to live our faith.

**(#3) It was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen**—It was granted her (those saved) for all is grace! Even our choice to humbly acknowledged His call and to follow in spirit and truth is the working of His grace.

**(#4) the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints**—**Jesus said** “I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.” John 15:5  
The priest when celebrating His sacrifice as the Lord has taught sings “In Him, through Him and with Him..”.

**(#5). Blessed are those invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.**—words from Mass quoted above!\*

**(#6) “These are the true words of God.”**—Blessed are the **humble** who believe and let it be done to them according to the true words of God.....AMEN
