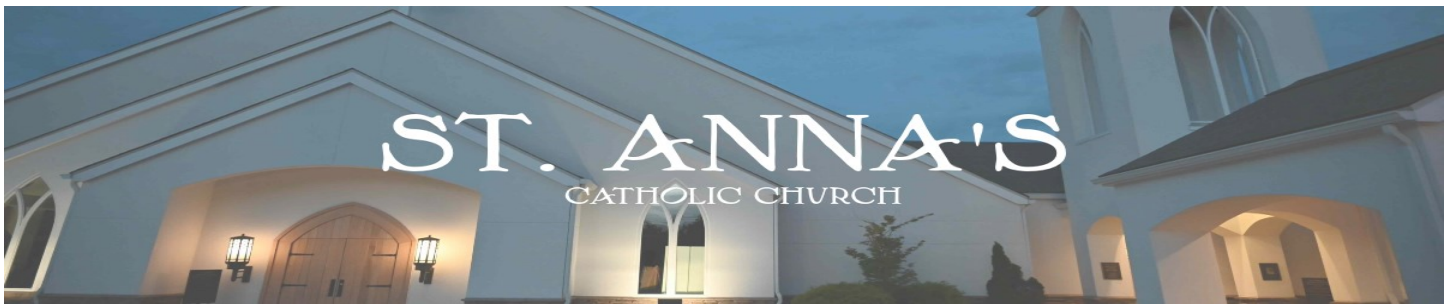

ST. CECILIA'S CORNER: UPDATES:

I wanted to offer several updates, the main one being the organ. The organ is nearing its final stages of completion. The builder is beginning to put the pipes into place, which is always the last task. The organ should arrive in the latter part of August. When it arrives, it will take about 2 weeks to re-assemble and set into the space. It is coming from Vermont, where it has been rebuilt. The dedication and blessing of the organ will take place on October 27 (Sunday) and Bishop Bernard Shlesinger will give the blessing. There will be a series of organ recitals offered over the next six months and tours of the organ will be offered to interested parties once a month. The organ is completely mechanical except for the electric blower, which makes it unique to north Georgia and to the state in general. The organ will be a powerful reminder of how beauty contributes to the Mass. Organs have been a part of the Church's liturgy since the 13th century.

Choirs will reassemble in August. Boy choir, girl choir, adult and training choir will be offered. I want to have more children involved this year and a special emphasis will be on getting boys to sing. Boys have long been an important component of the Church's choral tradition and history tells us that boys have been singing for Mass since the 5th century.

Think about being in choir and having your child be a part of the singing tradition. After all, to quote St. Augustine, "the one who sings prays twice."

Lastly, I will be on vacation from June 28 until July 22. I look forward to a little respite and spending time with my wife.

If you become aware of or have a reasonable suspicion of abuse you are required to report within 24 hours by Georgia law. Reports of child abuse and neglect can be made by phone to 1-855-GA CHILD (1-855-422-4453) 24 hours/day, 7 days/week. Archdiocesan policy requires a follow up letter to be sent to your local DFCS office detailing all the information provided to the intake center in order to keep records of our response to allegations of abuse. A copy of the letter also needs to be sent to the Office of Child and Youth Protection.

If an allegation of abuse involves any member of the clergy, employee, or volunteer of the Archdiocese of Atlanta, you must contact the Office of the District Attorney and the Office of Child and Youth Protection in addition to DFCS within 24 hours.
