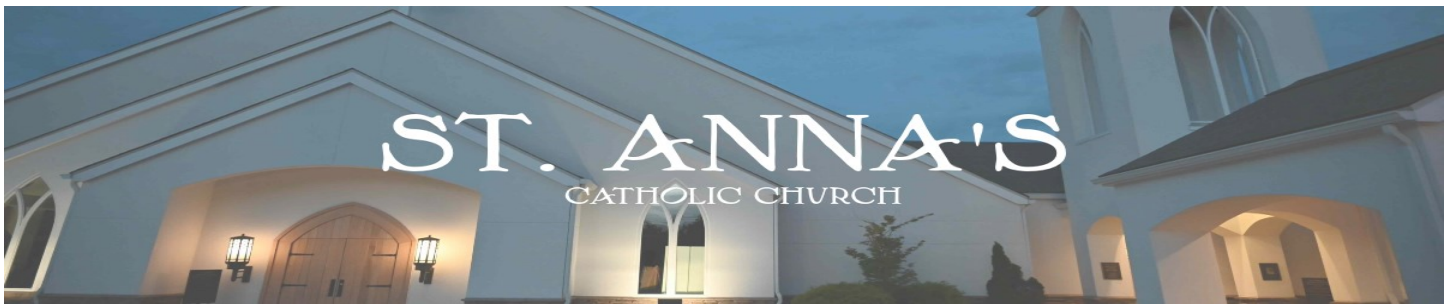

ST. CECILIA'S CORNER:

Patronal Feasts (Part 1)

On July 28 (Sunday) this summer, we shall celebrate the Feast of St. Anna (and her husband Joachim). This is the name of the parish and as such, her feast day carries a special weight among us. But as often is the case, why should we do this and what does it mean?

So, we need to understand a couple of things to make sense of this celebration. Let's begin with the second century Church, which began the practice of celebrating Mass at the tombs of the saints. It was thought that the altar was the "tomb" of Christ and thus, one celebrated the feast of the saint on the day of their death (dies natalis or "birth into heaven"). After Christianity was acceptable in the public sphere (after the year 314), Christians built public Churches but continued the practice of celebrating at the tombs of the saints. Eventually that became impossible, so relics of the saints became a necessary feature of an altar. That is still mostly true today. Every altar in a Catholic Church should have a relic in it. That relic is placed there at the time of the altar's consecration. Thus, our altar should have a relic of St. Anna. Sadly, the placing of relics has been lost in the building of many new churches. Many churches do not have relics in them.

Next week we'll talk about the saint we are named for and how she functions in our liturgical life and our piety.

If you become aware of or have a reasonable suspicion of abuse you are required to report within 24 hours by Georgia law. Reports of child abuse and neglect can be made by phone to 1-855-GA CHILD (1-855-422-4453) 24 hours/day, 7 days/week.

Archdiocesan policy **requires** a follow up letter to be sent to your local DFCS office detailing all the information provided to the intake center in order to keep records of our response to allegations of abuse. A copy of the letter also needs to be sent to

the Office of Child and Youth Protection.

If an allegation of abuse involves any member of the clergy, employee, or volunteer of the Archdiocese of Atlanta, you must contact the Office of the District Attorney and the Office of Child and Youth Protection in addition to DFCS within 24 hours.
