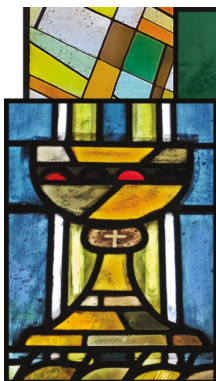

ROSARY RECITATION UPDATE:

Hello, Marian devotees and fans of the Rosary. How wonderful and helpful Our Lady is to us, and how much good she can do for us through her intercession to Jesus on our behalf. All we have to do is to be like little children, trusting in our Mother's love and concern.

During the weekends of July 6th, August 3rd, and September 7th, we will be praying the Rosary starting 40 minutes before Mass. We will be using "The Scriptural Rosary" format -- in which a scripture verse is recited before each Hail Mary.

The Rosary is a time-honored way to meditate on the lives of Jesus and Mary, and to ask for Mary's loving intercession for any practical, relational, or spiritual needs that we have. The Rosary is a powerful weapon against the Devil and a tremendous aid to Faith. Here is a quote from the concluding prayer of the Rosary:

"O God, whose only begotten Son, by His life, death and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant we beseech Thee, that by meditating upon these mysteries of the Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord, AMEN."

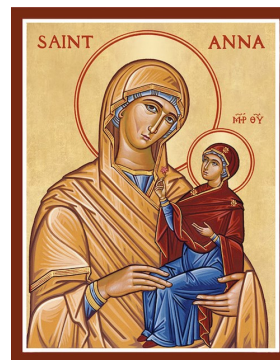

If you become aware of or have a reasonable suspicion of abuse you are required to report within 24 hours by Georgia law.

Reports of child abuse and neglect can be made by phone to 1-855-GA CHILD (1-855-422-4453) 24 hours/day, 7 days/week.

Archdiocesan policy **requires a follow up letter** to be sent to your local DFCS office detailing all the information provided to the intake center in order to keep records of our response to allegations of abuse. A copy of the letter also needs to be sent to the Office of Child and Youth Protection.

If an allegation of abuse involves any member of the clergy, employee, or volunteer of the Archdiocese of Atlanta, you must contact the Office of the District Attorney and the Office of Child and Youth Protection in addition to DFCS within 24 hours.
