NEW INITIATIVE FOR THE SINGING CHURCH



If you did not notice, our Holy Father sings. And he sings quite well. And he sings in the Church's tongue, that is to say, Latin. It is fair to say that Latin has returned to Rome and to the liturgies at St. Peter's Basilica. In the previous pontificate, most of the liturgies were in Italian, which is fascinating given that Francis spoke Italian rather poorly. But Leo, in as much as he is a canon lawyer, has an appreciation for Latin and clearly has demonstrated his use of it at Mass. Will we see more Latin? Of course. And to make it even more interesting, the Pontifical Institute for Sacred Music has produced a series of videos called, "Sing with the Pope." In the videos, Fr. Mehlhart, the director, introduces parts of the Mass such as the Lord's Prayer, the Ave Maria and other parts and helps the listener to understand and sing the parts in Latin. They are exceptionally well done and kudos to Fr. Mehlhart for his work. You can find them on YouTube. Look up "Sing with the Pope". Enjoy them as I have done. As one of my clergy friends has said, "Latin is coming back, thanks to our Holy Father." It's good to be Catholic!

If you become aware of or have a reasonable suspicion of abuse you are required to report within 24 hours by Georgia law.

Reports of child abuse and neglect can be made by phone to 1-855-GA CHILD (1-855-422-4453) 24 hours/day, 7 days/week.

Archdiocesan policy **requires a follow up letter** to be sent to your local DFCS office detailing all the information provided to the intake center in order to keep records of our response to allegations of abuse. A copy of the letter also needs

to be sent to the **Office of Child and Youth Protection**. If an allegation of abuse involves any member of the clergy,

employee, or volunteer of the Archdiocese of Atlanta, you must contact the Office of the District Attorney and the Office of

Child and Youth Protection in addition to DFCS within 24 hours.
