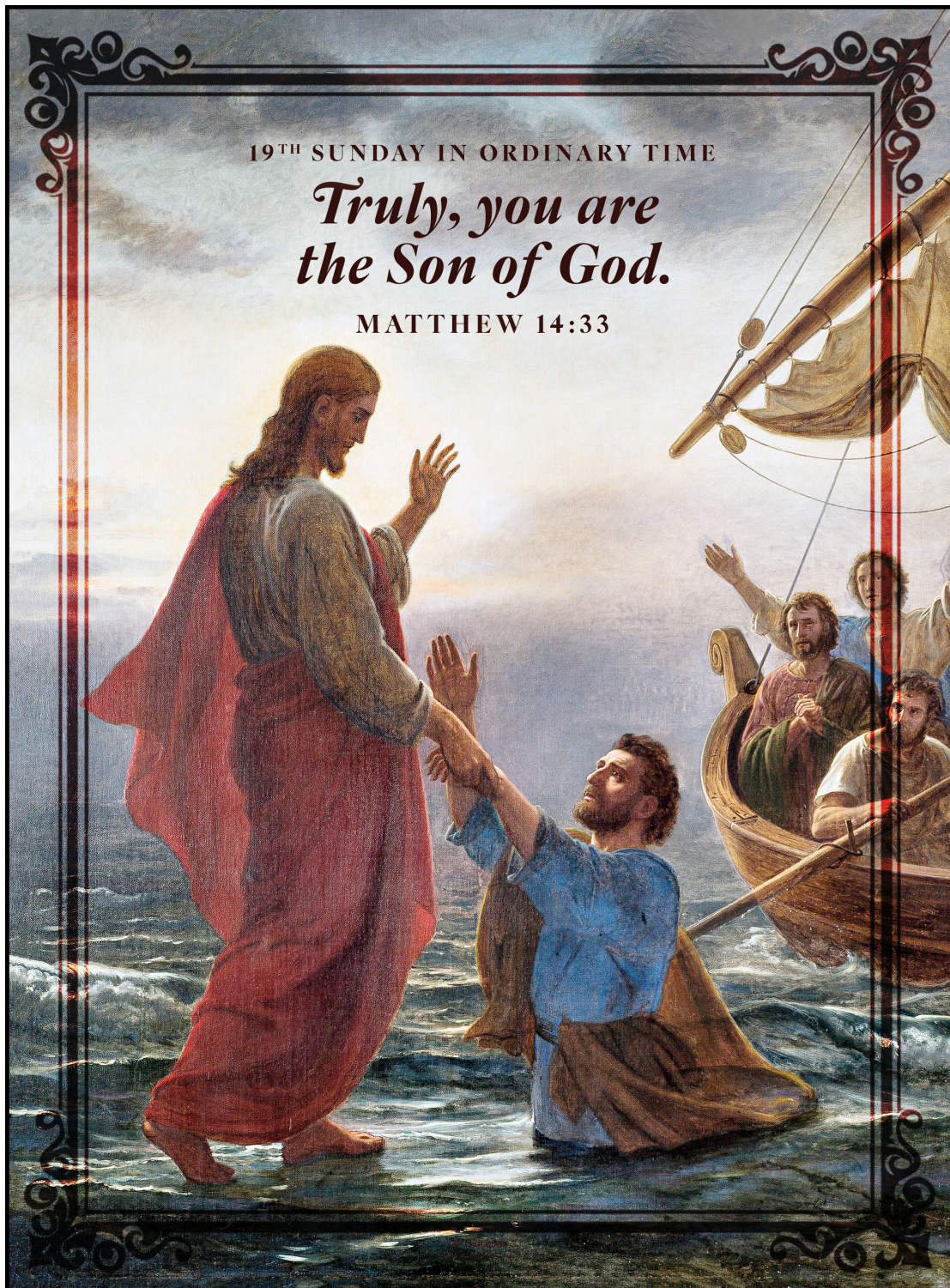

SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Lawrence Deacon and Martyr

Having died a martyr for Christ, St. Lawrence is the patron of deacons, chefs and firefighters. The testimony of this holy martyr, born in Spain in the first half of the 3rd century, is marked by piety and charity. His journey was shaken in youth by the drama of persecution. In AD 258, Emperor Valerian issued an edict: all bishops, priests and deacons must be put to death. Saint Lawrence, other deacons, and Pope Sixtus II were apprehended. The Pope was killed on 6 August. At first, the emperor offered to spare Lawrence's life, in exchange for his handing over of "the treasures of the Church." Lawrence is said to have presented the emperor with the sick, the needy, and the marginalized. These, he said, are the treasures of the Church. In the place of his martyrdom was built the church of San Lorenzo in Panisperna. According to some sources, the name derives from the custom of Franciscan friars and Poor Clares, of distributing bread and ham - panis et perna - to the poor on August 10, Saint Lawrence's feast day.

If you become aware of or have a reasonable suspicion of abuse you are required to report within 24 hours by Georgia law. Reports of child abuse and neglect can be made by phone to 1-855-GA CHILD (1-855-422-4453) 24 hours/day, 7 days/week. Archdiocesan policy requires a [follow up letter](#) to be sent to your local DFCS office detailing all the information provided to the intake center in order to keep records of our response to allegations of abuse. A copy of the letter also needs to be sent to the [Office of Child and Youth Protection](#). If an allegation of abuse involves any member of the clergy, employee, or volunteer of the Archdiocese of Atlanta, you must contact the Office of the District Attorney and the Office of Child and Youth Protection in addition to DFCS within 24 hours.
